Dear Sandy,

Thank you for your correspondence on the 23rd of April regarding the sale and distribution of motor vehicles in Scotland.

In your email you referred to the UK Government guidelines and dealerships in England being able to distance sell. The Scottish Government guidelines on this are included in our [guidance for business](#) which was updated most recently on the 21st of April. There are no regulations which stop motor vehicles being distance sold and delivered in Scotland, it is the showrooms which must remain closed.

Of course, any distance selling and delivery of motor vehicles must be undertaken while strictly adhering to the physical distancing guidelines which can be found [here](#). I'm sure that your members who choose to distance sell will do so in a responsible manner, ensuring that they protect employees and customers.
